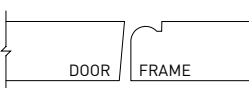
Beaded Inset

1/4" rounded bead added around the inner frame edge.



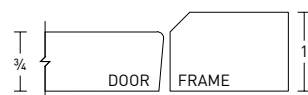
Beaded Inset

3/8" rounded bead added around the inner frame edge.



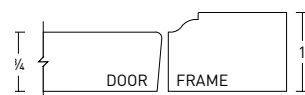
Sculpted Chamfer

1" thick frame with 45° beveled profile added around the inner frame edge.



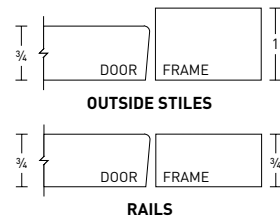
Sculpted Ogee

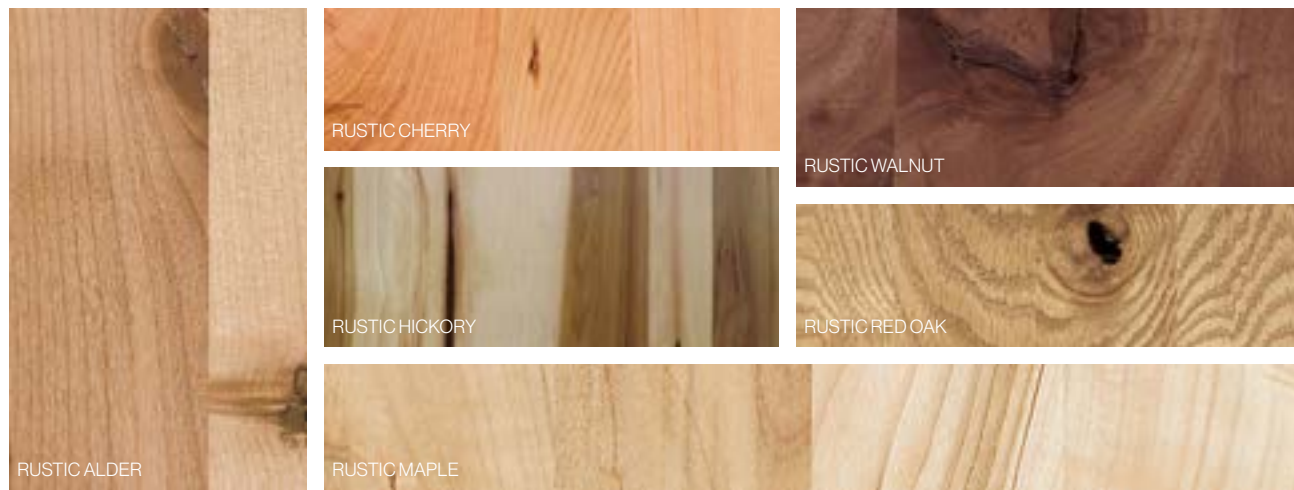


Species & Finish Options

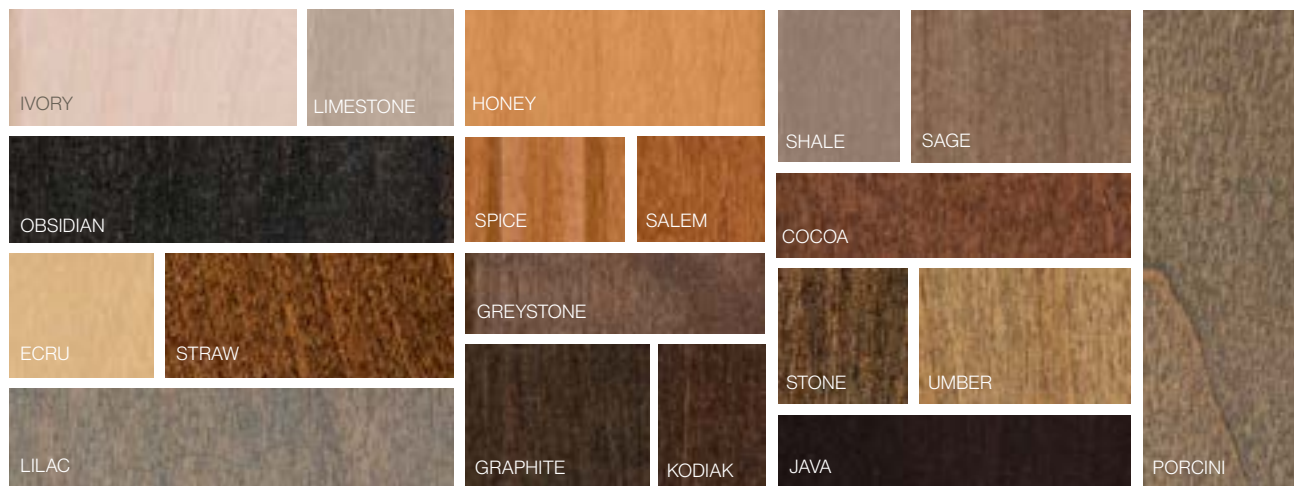

Includes random dents, nicks, rasp marks, worm-holing, bird-pecking and sanded or uneven edges.



VINTAGE

Natural wear simulated by sanding edges and corners after paint finish has been applied.

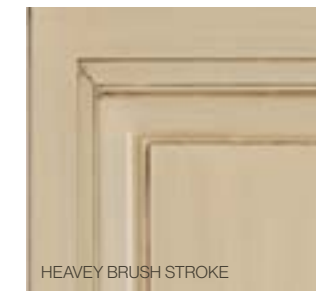
PENCIL EDGE SANDING

Subtle effect created by sanding the outside and detail edges of painted doors to expose the wood below.



LIGHT BRUSH STROKE

Simulated brush strokes are achieved via light sanding of the paint along the grain prior to glazing.*



HEAVEY BRUSH STROKE

Simulated brush strokes are achieved via heavy sanding of the paint along the grain prior to glazing.*



BISQUE

A special brown glaze, accents, and sand-through are applied to a painted finish.

HIGHLIGHT GLAZE

Hand-applied technique adds a highlight to door details with a thin line.



ANTIQUÉ GLAZE

Glaze is wiped on and off, leaving lingering glaze in the open grain and details of the door.*

*The underlying color will be altered when the glaze is applied to the surface

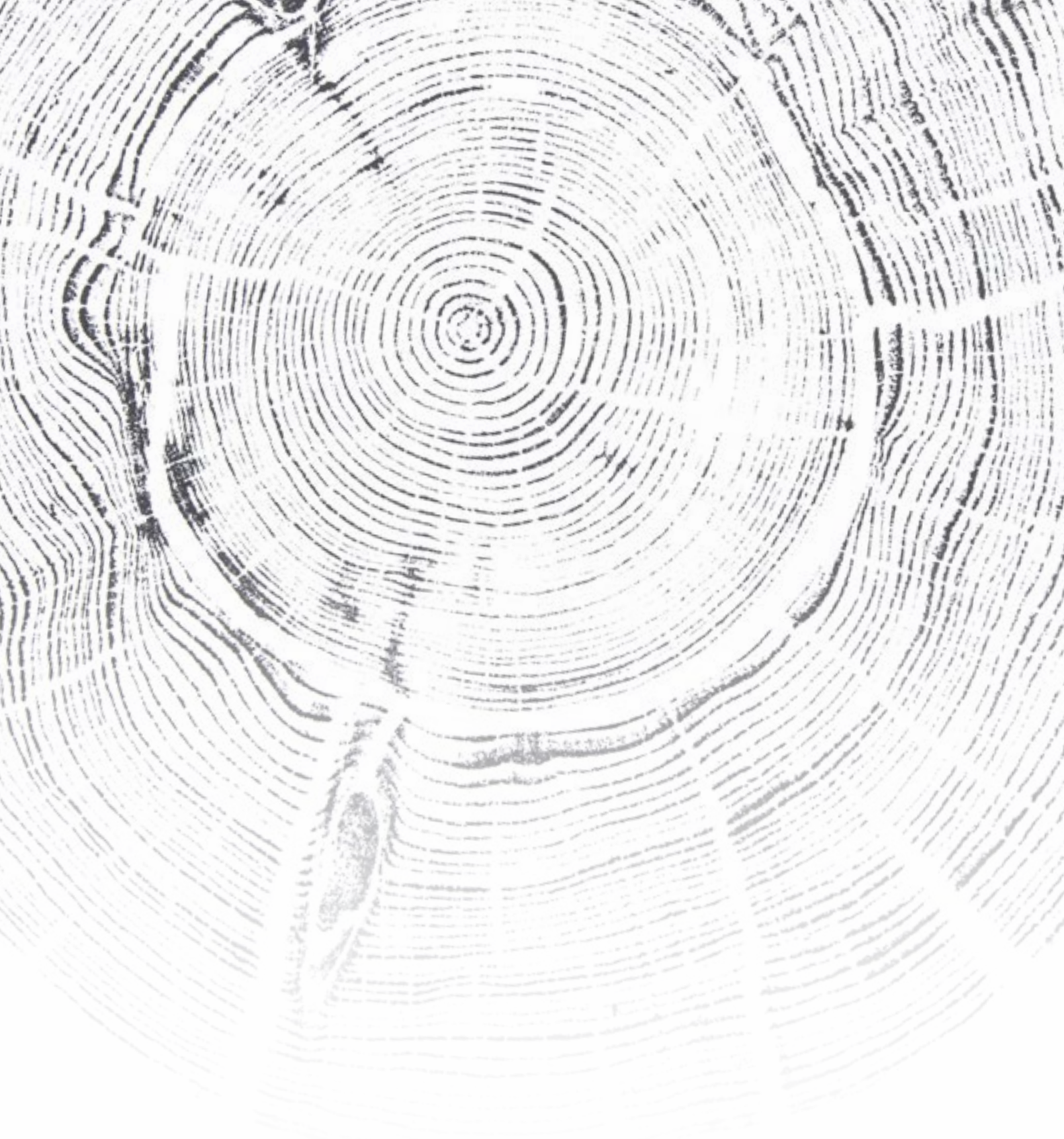
